

Residential Monitoring

Under the Residential Special School National Minimum Standards (RSSNMS), the residential side of Marland school has to be monitored by an Independent visitor (RSSNMS Standard 20). This independent visitor will visit for a minimum of six times a year and complete a written report on the conduct of the school.

These monitoring visits will often be unannounced; on all visits the independent visitor will speak with senior leaders, staff and students as well as monitor records, ensure the students are safeguarded and look at the physical condition of the building furniture and equipment.

The Schools Independent Visitor is Dr Nicola Farmer, who has a wealth of experience in education and health settings.
