

There are over 350 different careers available in the NHS. The NHS is the largest healthcare employer in England. It employs over 1.3 million staff*. This includes staff in hospital, ambulance, community and mental health services. Nearly two in ten NHS jobs are non-clinical such as admin, security, porter, HR, IT and management work. In social care, you can help people in their own homes, in care homes or in other places such as day centres or supported housing. Apprenticeships are from levels 2 to 7.
